



Knitting 101

This class is for those who want to learn how to knit. The class will cover types of needles, yarn and notions frequently used. Students will learn to cast on, knit and bind off. This is a one and a half hour class.

Prerequisite: None. This is a beginner class

Supplies Needed: 100 yards of a light colored chunky weight yarn and a pair of size 10 needles

Cost: \$20

Knitting 201

This class is the follow up to Knitting 101 and great for those who already know how to cast on, knit and bind off. Students will learn to purl, and a few types of increases and decreases. This is a one and a half hour class.

Prerequisite: Students must already possess the knowledge to cast on, knit and bind off.

Supplies Needed: 100 yards of a light colored chunky weight yarn and a pair of size 10 needles

Cost: \$20

My First Knitting Project

In this class, students will learn how to select a beginning knitting pattern best suited for their skills, understand how a pattern is organized, learn pattern abbreviations, choose the best yarn and needles and work on the project with an instructor. Students can continue to take this class until their project is finished. This is a one hour class.

Prerequisite: Students must already possess the knowledge to cast on, knit, purl, increase, decrease and bind off. Students are encouraged to take the 101 and/or 201 class if a brush up is needed.

Supplies Needed: Pattern and supplies of student's choice w/ instructor assistance.

Cost: \$10
